

# Yarn Wrist Bag (Crochet Version)

Designed by Tandy Imhoff

Finished Size: 4 ½" circumference & 3 ½" deep. Will hold a standard wound ball of Cascade 220.

## Materials:

- 1 ball of yarn (less than 100 yds) (sport weight is was used for this pattern, though any weight can be used, just work less or more increase and depth rounds based on the weight of your yarn)
- Crochet hook (Size F was used for the pattern, though base the size to your yarn)
- 1 – ¼" nylon ring (optional)
- Tapestry needle

## Directions:

Sc 8 times around the nylon ring, sl st to join. (If you do not want the hole in the bottom, then ch 4, sl st into a ring, and sc 8 times into the joined loop.) The hole in the bottom allows you to pull from both the center and outside of the ball at the same time for double-stranding, while keeping the yarn from tangling.

Round 1: Ch 1, sc in same, \*ch 1, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* around, sl st to join.

Round 2: Sl st into the ch sp, (ch 2, hdc) into the ch 1 sp, \*ch 2, 2 hdc in next ch 1 sp. Repeat from \* around, ch 2, sl st to join.

Round 3: Sl st to the ch 2 sp, (ch 2, 2 hdc) in the same space, \*ch 2, 3 hdc in the next ch 2 sp. Repeat from \* around, ch 2, sl st to join.

Round 4: Sl st to the ch 2 sp, (ch 2, 3 hdc) in the same space, \*ch 2, 4 hdc in the next ch 2 sp. Repeat from \* around, ch 2, sl st to join.

Round 5: Sl st to the ch 2 sp, (ch 2, 4 hdc) in the same space, \*ch 2, 5 hdc in the next ch 2 sp. Repeat from \* around, ch 2, sl st to join.

Round 6: Sl st to the ch 2 sp, (ch 2, 2 hdc, ch 2, 3 hdc) in the same space, \*(ch 2, 3 hdc) twice in the next ch 2 space. Repeat from \* around, ch 2, sl st to join.

Round 7: Sl st to the ch 2 sp, (ch 2, 2 hdc) in the same space, \*ch 2, 3 hdc in the next ch 2 space. Repeat from \* around, ch 2, sl st to join. (4 ½" across)

Repeat round 7, eleven times or until the bag measures approximately 5" from the center. If you wish the bag to be deeper for store bought balls of yarn, continue round 7 to ½" short of desired depth.

Finish Round 1: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in ch 2 sp, \*hdc in next 3 hdc, 2 hdc in next ch 2 sp. Repeat from \* around, sl st to join.

Finish Round 2: Ch 2, hdc in next 7 hdc, dec, \*hdc in next 8 hdc, dec. Repeat from \* around, sl st to join. [To dec, (yo, insert hook in next st, pull through loop, yo), pull loop through 2 loops, repeat between (), pull loop through all 4 loops on hook.]

Handle: Ch 1, sc in next 6 hdc. Turn, sc in 6 sc. Repeat last step until it measures 8" or desired length. Sew or sl st to opposite side of bag.
