

Top Short Row Edging *(uses approximately 85 yds for 202 sts)*

Work the following Rows 1 - 11 once, then repeat Rows 4 - 11 until you have 4 stitches left from the shawl's top edge stitches.

- Row 1: Purl (RS)
- Row 2: K1, kf&b, k1. Turn.
- Row 3: K2, yo3x, k2. Turn.
- Row 4: K2, (k1, p1, k1) in yo, k2. Turn. (7 sts)
- Row 5: K2tog, k5. Turn. (6 sts)
- Row 6: K5, yo, k2tog, sl1 wyif. Turn. (8 sts)
- Row 7: K2tog, k1, k2tog, k3. Turn. (6 sts)
- Row 8: K4, yo, k2tog. Turn.
- Row 9: K6. Turn.
- Row 10: BO 3, k1, yo, k1, sl1 wyif. Turn. (5 sts)
- Row 11: K2tog, k1, yo3x, k2. Turn.

Now work the following rows once. (See pattern notes if your remaining stitch count is not 4.)

- Final Row 1: K2, (k1, p1, k1) in yo, k2. Turn.
- Final Row 2: K2tog, k2, k2tog, k1. Turn.
- Final Row 3: K4, yo, k2tog, sl1 wyif. Turn.
- Final Row 4: K2tog, k1, k2tog twice. Turn.
- Final Row 5: K1, k2tog, k1, yo, k1. Turn.
- Final Row 6: K2tog, sl1, k2tog, pssso, pass second stitch over first. (1 st)

Pull yarn through remaining stitch and fasten off.

Bottom Short Row Edging *(uses approximately 85 yds for 202 sts)*

Worked on provisional cast-on stitches or pickup 202 sts (or original cast on number) from the cast-on edge.

Start instructions below on the bottom left corner (wrong side facing).

Work Rows 1– 14 once, then work Rows 7 - 14 to the last 2 sts.

- Row 1: K1, kf&b, sl1 wyif. Turn. (4 sts)
- Row 2: K2tog, k2. Turn. (3 sts)
- Row 3: K2tog, k1, kf&b 2x. Turn. (6 sts)
- Row 4: K6. Turn.
- Row 5: K5, k2tog. Turn. (6 sts)
- Row 6: K6. Turn.
- Row 7: BO3, k1, yo, k1, sl1 wyif. Turn. (5 sts)
- Row 8: K2tog, k1, yo3x, k2. Turn.
- Row 9: K2, (k1, p1, k1) in yo, k2. Turn. (7 sts)
- Row 10: K2tog, k5. Turn. (6 sts)
- Row 11: K5, yo, k2tog, sl1 wyif. Turn. (8 sts)
- Row 12: K2tog, k1, k2tog, k3. Turn. (6 sts)
- Row 13: K4, yo, k2tog. Turn.
- Row 14: K6. Turn.

Now work the following Final Rows once (see pattern notes, if your remaining stitch count is not 2).

- Final Row 1: K4, k2tog, sl1 wyif. Turn. (6 sts)
 - Final Row 2: K2tog, k4. (5 sts)
 - Final Row 3: K1, k2tog twice, sl1 wyif. Turn. (4 sts)
 - Final Row 4: K2tog twice, pass first stitch over second. (1 st)
- Pull yarn through remaining stitch and fasten off. Weave in ends and block entire shawl. Sew 3 buttons approximately 4" apart starting at the outside edge, above the Bottom Edging on the WS, on each end. Use the eyelets created by the edging as buttonholes on the other side.
- Buttons should start just inside the edging and finish about 3" from the underarm, depending on the length of your shawl, you may decide to use more or fewer buttons.

Chart Instructions:

Provisional cast on 202 stitches.

Knit one row, this is the WS of the shawl.

Then starting on the opposite page work Chart 1A & 1B in sequence.

Repeat entire chart a total of four times (or the number [D] you found on page 3).

Then work Top Edging to bind off and add edging at the same time.

Then, on the provisional cast on stitches, work Bottom Edging. Follow finishing instructions at the end of the Bottom Edging.

(K)	Knit
(P)	Purl
	No stitch
○	(YO) Yarn over, wrap yarn around needle once
∩	(Kf&b) knit into the front and back of the stitch
^	(K2tog) Knit two stitches together as one
λ	(Sl1-k1-pssso) Slip one stitch purl-wise, knit the next stitch, pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch
△	(P2tog) purl two stitches together as one
^	(Sl1-k2tog-pssso) Slip one stitch purl-wise, knit the next two stitches together, pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch
^	(Sl2-k3tog-pssso) Slip two stitches purl-wise, knit the next three stitches together, pass both slipped stitches over the knit stitch
∩	(BO) Bind off each stitch
